For Baptized Children Preparing for First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Preparation for the sacraments at the Cathedral of Saint Andrew is based on your child's grade level and prior sacramental history. All children must be baptized Catholic before beginning sacramental preparation.

First Holy Communion – 2nd Grade

Baptized Catholic children in 2nd grade prepare for First Holy Communion by:

- Attending **weekly Sunday PRE classes at 11:00 AM**
- Participating in **2 Saturday morning retreats**
- Celebrating **First Penance (Reconciliation)**

First Holy Communion – Grades 3 to 6

Baptized Catholic children in grades 3–6 who have not yet received First Holy Communion will:

- Attend **weekly Sunday PRE grade-level classes at 11:00 AM**
- Participate in **12 special parent-and-child classes at 10:00 AM** (held before PRE)
- Attend **2 Saturday morning retreats**
- Celebrate **First Penance (Reconciliation)**

First Holy Communion – Grade 7 and Older

Baptized Catholic youth in **7th grade or higher** who need First Holy Communion will:

- Attend **weekly Wednesday evening PRE classes**
- Participate in **all Saturday Confirmation preparation retreats** (required)
- Celebrate **First Penance (Reconciliation)**

Confirmation – Grade 8 and Older

Baptized Catholic youth preparing for Confirmation (normally in **8th grade or above**) will:

- Attend **weekly Wednesday evening PRE classes**
- Participate in **all Saturday Confirmation preparation retreats**

Unbaptized Children/Youth (Ages 7–16) Preparing for Sacraments

At the Cathedral of Saint Andrew, unbaptized children and youth (ages 7 to 16, typically grades 2 through 10) prepare for **Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion**, through a process adapted from the adult OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults). This adapted process is called the **Order of Initiation of Children of Catechetical Age (OICCA)**.

Overview of the OICCA Process

- ✓ **Duration:** A minimum of **two years**
- ✓ **Participation:** Children & youth attend **grade-level Parish Religious Education (PRE) classes** alongside baptized peers
 - **Children (grades 2–6):** Sunday PRE classes at **11:00 AM**
 - **Youth (grades 7–10):** Wednesday PRE classes at **6:15 PM**
- ✓ **Additionally, children and youth participate** in parent and children classes
 - **22 special parent-and-child sessions** held **Sundays at 10:00 AM** (before PRE class)
 - **2 Saturday retreats** each year

Sample OICCA Journey #1: José (Unbaptized, Begins in 3rd Grade)

Year 1: Foundations of Faith (3rd Grade)

- In **August**, José is enrolled in **3rd grade** as an **unbaptized child**.
- He begins attending **Sunday PRE grade-level classes** with his baptized peers
☑**Time:** 11:00–11:55 AM
- In **November**, he and his parent(s) begin attending **special parent-and-child classes**
☑**Time:** 10:00–11:00 AM (followed by the regular 11:00 AM class)
☑**Schedule:** November through April
- In **mid-January**, José celebrates the **Rite of Entrance**
- He attends the **two Saturday retreats** offered during the year.
- By the end of Year 1, José:
 - Has faithfully attended both the 10:00 AM and 11:00 AM classes, and the two retreats
 - Has celebrated the **Rite of Entrance**
 - Is growing in faith and learning alongside peers

Year 2: Preparation for Initiation (4th Grade)

- In **August**, José is enrolled in **4th grade**.
- He resumes **Sunday PRE grade-level classes** at 11:00–11:55 AM.
- In **late September**, José celebrates the **Rite of Anointing**.
- In **November**, he and his parent(s) begin the second round of **special parent-and-child classes**
☑**Time:** Sundays, 10:00–11:00 AM
☑**Schedule:** November through January
- In **mid-January**, he celebrates the **Rite of the Lord's Prayer**.
- During **Lent**, José celebrates a **Penitential Rite**.
- He attends the one **Lenten Saturday retreat**.
- His catechists discern that José is spiritually ready to receive the sacraments.

✓ José joyfully celebrates the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil.

Sample OICCA Journey #2: Maria (Unbaptized, Begins in 8th Grade)

Year 1: Foundations of Faith (8th Grade)

- In **August**, Maria is enrolled in **8th grade** as an **unbaptized youth**.
- She begins attending **Wednesday evening PRE grade-level classes** with her baptized peers
☑**Time:** 6:15–8:30 PM
- In **November**, she and her parent(s) begin attending special parent-and-child classes on Sundays
☑**Time:** 10:00–11:00 AM (followed by the regular Wednesday evening class)
☑**Schedule:** November through April
- In **mid-January**, Maria celebrates the **Rite of Entrance** during a Wednesday Class.
- She attends the **Saturday Confirmation Class Retreat**.
- By the end of Year 1, Maria:
 - Has faithfully attended her 6:15 PM Wednesday class and 10:00 AM Sunday class, and a retreat
 - Has participated in the **Rite of Entrance**
 - Is growing in faith and commitment alongside her peers

Year 2: Preparation for Initiation (9th Grade)

- In **August**, Maria is enrolled in **9th grade**.
- She resumes attending **Wednesday evening PRE grade-level classes**
☑**Time:** 6:15–8:30 PM
- In **late September**, she celebrates the **Rite of Anointing** during Wednesday Class.
- In **November**, she and her parent(s) begin the second round of special parent-and-child/youth classes
☑**Time:** Sundays, 10:00–11:00 AM
☑**Schedule:** November through January
- In **mid-January**, she celebrates the **Rite of the Lord's Prayer**.
- During Lent, Maria participates in:
 - Rite of Election** with the Bishop on the first Sunday of Lent (3:00–4:30 PM)
 - Penitential Rite** at Wednesday class.
 - Saturday Confirmation Class retreat**
- Her catechists discern that Maria is spiritually ready to receive the sacraments..

✓ Maria joyfully celebrates the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil.
